
ITINERARY:

Day 1, arrive in Dubrovnik, Sunday

You will be transferred from the airport or your hotel in Dubrovnik to Gruz Harbor where embarkation begins at noon. Later, meet your fellow travelers and your Cruise Manager for an onboard Welcome Reception and Dinner. This evening, you can relax on board or take a stroll through Dubrovnik's Old Town. **(D)**

Day 2, Dubrovnik – Mljet, Monday

We start the day with breakfast and a walking tour of Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of Adriatic" and a UNESCO World Heritage site. We visit the **Rector's Palace** and the Franciscan Monastery's **Pharmacy** before returning to the ship. While we set sail for Mljet Island, lunch is served. **Mljet National Park** features five types of forest, many species of birds, and two deep lakes called Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and Malo Jezero (Small Lake). This amazing island was supposedly a favorite holiday spot for the Greek hero Ulysses! The evening is at leisure. **(B, L)**

Day 3, Mljet – Korcula, Tuesday

After breakfast, we enjoy spectacular coastal scenery, en route to Korcula, believed to be the birthplace of the explorer Marco Polo. Our walking tour of Korcula takes us through its narrow, cobble-stone streets and includes a visit to the majestic Gothic-Baroque **Cathedral of St. Mark**. **(B, L)**

Day 4, Korcula – Vela Luka, Wednesday

This morning we sail along the beautiful island of Korcula. There is time to swim in the Adriatic Sea. After lunch onboard, we disembark in Vela Luka (the “big harbor”) town, dating back to pre-historic times, and we depart for an afternoon ‘Korcula island tour’. On the island, we **visit of an olive oil mill, the Barilo Ethno Museum, and a vineyard for wine and cheese tasting**. Afterward, we return to the M/S Prestige, for an evening at leisure. **(B, L)**

Day 5, Vela Luka – Vis, Thursday

After breakfast, we cruise towards Vis Island, arguably one of the most beautiful islands off the Croatian coast. The small and historic town of Vis was founded around 397 B.C. In 2017 the movie “Mama Mia! Here We Go Again” was filmed here. Our tour of Vis features the town’s waterfront and its spectacular and unspoiled nature. The evening is at leisure. **(B, L)**

Day 6, Vis – Hvar – Stari Grad, Friday

Our cruise continues towards Hvar, one of the most popular islands in the Adriatic Sea and a rendezvous point for the international jet-set. The “Croatian Madeira” is also one of the longest islands in the Adriatic. Our sightseeing tour of Hvar includes the first public theatre in Europe, the Franciscan Monastery and many more historical sights. We then sail on to Stari Grad for the night. Onboard our ship tonight, there is the **Captain’s dinner** with live entertainment and a glass of wine. **(B, L, D)**

Day 7, Stari Grad – Bol – Split, Saturday

We sail to Bol, home to one of the most breathtaking beaches in Croatia: the Golden Horn. This vast, golden pebble beach is unique in that it changes shape and position depending on the direction of the winds. During lunch on board, we continue sailing to Split. Here, a walking tour shows off the historic inner city, built around the Palace of the Roman Emperor **Diocletian**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. We also see the remnants of Split’s Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter’s Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. The evening is free to explore even more in Split. **(B, L)**

Day 8, depart Split, Sunday

We then see the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, it's Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. After the walking tour, we set sail towards Bol, home to one of the most breathtaking beaches in Croatia: the Golden Horn. This vast, golden pebble beach is unique in that it changes shape and position depending on the direction of the winds. After a swim, we head to Hvar, one of the most popular islands in the Adriatic and a rendezvous point for the international jet-set. The "Croatian Madeira" is also one of the longest islands in the Adriatic. We spend the evening and overnight docked in Stari Grad, one of the oldest towns in Europe. **(B, L)**

Day 3, Stari Grad – Hvar – Vis, Tuesday

Following breakfast, there is a short sail towards the island and town of Hvar for a sightseeing tour featuring the first public theatre in Europe, the Franciscan Monastery and many more historical sights. Then we cruise towards the Island of Vis, arguably one of the most beautiful islands off the Croatia coast. The small and historic town of Vis was founded around 397 B.C. In 2017, the movie "Mama Mia! Here We Go Again" was filmed here. Our tour of Vis features the town's waterfront and its spectacular and unspoiled nature. The evening is at leisure. **(B, L)**

Day 3, Korcula – Hvar, Tuesday

This morning, after breakfast, we take a walking tour through the narrow, cobble-stone streets of Korcula town. Our visit includes a visit to the majestic Gothic-Baroque **Cathedral of St. Mark**. Afterward, we board our ship again and enjoy lunch. We stop for a swim en route to Hvar where we arrive late afternoon. There, during our sightseeing tour, we see the first public theatre in Europe, the Franciscan Monastery and much more. Our evening is free in Hvar so you can explore even more and dine on your own at one of the many restaurants in town. **(B, L)**

Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Hvar harbor (during peak season in July and August) the port of call can be substituted for Stari Grad/Jelsa. In that case, transfers by bus will be organized to and from Hvar.

In the morning, we sail to the UNESCO-listed city of Trogir. Our time here is free to explore on your own. Back on board, enjoy lunch as we cruise to Sibenik, with a stop for a swim on the way. In Sibenik, a walking tour shows us the highlights of the city, then our evening is at leisure. **(B, L)**

Day 6, Sibenik – Sali, Friday


The Sibenik area is home to two National Parks: **Krka**, with its breathtaking waterfalls, and **Kornati**, comprised of more than 140 islands with numerous coves and crystal-clear water. The day is devoted to tour these scenic destinations before we sail to Sali. Tonight, aboard our ship, enjoy the **Captain's dinner** with live entertainment and a glass of wine. **(B, L, D)**

Day 7, Sali – Zadar, Saturday

As we cruise this morning, and weather permitting, we stop for a swim. After lunch, we arrive in Zadar. The city's compact pedestrian zone is perfect to explore on foot. We admire the 16th century walls built by the Venetians as a defense against the Turks. We also see the Port Gate where the Venetian lion still guards the entrance, the Square of the Five Wells, the **Church of St. Donat**, the Roman Forum, and the largest cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia. After the tour, we stop for a **tasting of traditional Maraschino liqueur**. The evening is free in Zadar. **(B, L)**

Day 8, depart Zadar, Sunday

We disembark after breakfast, and bid our ship and crew farewell. You will be transferred to Zadar or Split airport or to your Zadar or Split hotel. Alternatively, continue on to join a Kompas' escorted tour. **(B)**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What currency is used on board?

The Croatian Kuna is the only currency accepted on board. Only cash payments are possible. Credit Cards are NOT accepted on board. Currency Exchange offices and ATM's are available in most ports of call.

2. Is it possible to do laundry onboard?

Unfortunately, laundry service is not available on board.

3. Is there a dress code on board? What clothes should I bring?

There is no need to bring evening gowns or formal wear. Casual dress is accepted throughout the cruise.

4. Can we bring food and drinks on board?

Unfortunately, outside food and drinks cannot be brought on board.

5. How many pieces of luggage can I bring? Is there enough space in my cabin to store my luggage?

You are allowed to bring 1 piece of luggage per person on board. All cabins have 1 small closet to hang your clothes and store your belonging.

6. Is there any entertainment offered on board?

There is no entertainment on board. However, during the Captain's Dinner, there is live music. On the ship you will find a small selection of board games. Every cabin has a TV with various international channels. There is also free Wi-Fi on board.

7. Are there any extra costs that are not included in the cruise-fare?

Gratuities/tips are not included but greatly appreciated. Gratuities for the cruise manager and for the cruise staff are usually left in one or two envelope(s) on the last night of the cruise. We provide tipping suggestions in the travel documents which you receive around 20 days prior to the Cruise departure.

8. Are any dietary or allergy restrictions guaranteed?

Kindly provide your dietary and food allergy requests at least 90 days prior to your cruise start date. Our chefs will do all possible to accommodate your restrictions.

9. Can you accommodate more than 3 people per cabin?

There are cabins with double and twin beds on all of our ships and they are for the right size for single or double use. There are a few larger cabins on the lower deck that can fit 3 passengers. There are no cabins for more than 3 people.

10. Do you provide transfers? Are transfers included in the cruise-fare?

Yes, most arrival and departure transfers are included in the cruise-fare. On the day of embarkation (only) we will transfer you from the nearest airport (usually within 15 miles from the cruise-port) to the ship. If you join from a Kompas tour, or if you have booked a hotel with Kompas before your cruise, we will also transfer you to the ship. At the end of your cruise, we will transfer you to the nearest airport or, if you have extended your stay with Kompas, to your hotel in the disembarkation city. If you have made your own pre- or post-cruise (lodging) arrangements, we cannot provide transfers to or from the ship.

11. Do you offer meals on board or is there room service outside of the program inclusions?

No, the onboard kitchen is only open for included meals. Unfortunately, room service is not available. There is a (cash only) bar on the ship and opening hours vary.

12. Can you provide the exact address for embarkation and disembarkation?

The ship's docking point is usually assigned by the Croatian Authorities one day prior to Cruise arrival or departure. If you are planning to arrive on your own, please contact our emergency phone number listed on your travel documents to confirm the ship's location.

13. Who should I contact in case I experience a delay on my flight or cannot find my (transfer) driver?

Please always call the emergency contact number listed on the travel documents if you are having trouble joining the cruise. During the Cruise or Tour, the Cruise or Tour Manager will be your primary point of contact.

14. Is smoking permitted on board the ship?

Smoking inside the cabins and in most common areas is not permitted. Most ships have a small designated area where smoking is allowed.

1. You are the Traveler and Kompas Holidays International (dba as Kompas America, Kompas Holidays, Kompas Vacations, Kompas USA or Kompas), hereinafter "Kompas" is the Sales Company. 5. Deposit & payment: A non-refundable, non-transferable, per person, per vacation deposit of €150 per person is required at the time of booking. The deposit forms part of your final payment which is due in full at least 45 days prior to departure. If we do not receive final payment by that time, your reservation cancels and full cancellation penalties apply. In the case of billing errors, we reserve the right to re-invoice you with the correct pricing. Some travel arrangements may require additional deposits. In such instances, you will be advised thereof at the time of booking. Only your Kompas invoice confirms that your payment is processed and that your booking is accepted.
6.
