8 DAYS FROM 1136 €

Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split's airport or your Split hotel to harbour, where embarkation begins at 13:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome Reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 SPLIT – STARI GRAD, Sunday (B, L)

Morning sail towards Stari Grad on the island of Hvar. Swimming stop and lunch on board. Stari Grad is one of the oldest towns in Europe with many friendly and cheap konobas and restaurants in the backstreets of the old town. The Stari Grad Plain and the old town centre of Stari Grad have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 2008. Your evening is free to explore Stari Grad on your own.

Day 3 STARI GRAD – HVAR – KORČULA (Wine tasting), Monday (B, L, T)

Morning departure towards the town of Hvar on the island of Hvar, the most popular island in the Adriatic and a meeting point for the international jet set. A sightseeing tour of this charming town, with 8 centuries of architecture, will show you the picturesque little streets and the first public theatre in Europe (older than Shakespeare's theatre in the UK). Afterwards we set sail for Korčula, with swimming stop in one of pristine bays and lunch onboard. Early afternoon arrival to Korčula, thought to be the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Take a walking tour through this fortified town which is one of the best preserved medieval cities in the Mediterranean and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. Your evening is free to discover the town and enjoy dinner on your own at one of the many good restaurants.

Day 4 KORČULA – DUBROVNIK, Tuesday (B, L)

In the morning sail to Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic", a UNESCO World Heritage site. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, you will enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent Old Town with a panoramic bus ride above the Old Town. After the panoramic view, we will arrive at the historical centre of Dubrovnik, walk through STRADUN – both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, the famous city enlisted as UNESCO's World Heritage site, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik. After city tour, you will be left on your own to explore the city, visit City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's second oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace and the Cathedral, take a boat ride to Lokrum island or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Srđ. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Day 5 DUBROVNIK – MLJET, Wednesday (B, L)

Today we turn our compass back north towards Mljet Island, with plenty of time for morning swim along the sail. Upon arrival join the Cruise Manager for a visit to the famous salt lakes in the National Park and enjoy the boat ride to St. Mary Isle to visit an ancient Benedictine monastery, an old abbey and a Church dating back to the 12th Century. Mljet National Park encompasses five types of forest, many species of birds, and two deep lakes, Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and Malo Jezero (Small Lake). Your evening is free in Mljet.

Day 6 MLJET – PUČIŠĆA, Thursday (B, L, CD)

Take a break for a swim during your morning cruise. Continue sailing through lunch, arriving this afternoon in Pučišća, a beautiful little town on island of Brač. Pučišća, village of the stone sculpture, where you can visit amazing stonemason school (optional), features a spectacular steep-sided natural harbour and authentic Mediterranean architecture. Tonight enjoy Captain's dinner onboard.

Day 7 PUČIŠĆA – OMIŠ – SPLIT, Friday (B, L)

Next we head to our final port Omiš with its fortresses which are silent stone reminders of the power of the pirates who once made their homes and fortunes here. You will have a possibility to book a short walking tour, followed by boarding a small boat and sail into Cetina River Canyon, a protected nature area, continuing to Radman Mills for a local specialty snack (optional). After visiting Omiš set sail to Split with a stop along the way to swim, cool off and relax, if weather permits, with lunch onboard. In the late afternoon we arrive in Split to take a guided tour of the historical center of city which is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Your evening is free in Split.

Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split's airport or your Split hotel to harbour, where embarkation begins at 13:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 SPLIT – NP KRKA – ŠIBENIK, Sunday (B, L)

Depart from Split early in the morning towards Šibenik. After lunch disembark in Šibenik and take the bus to visit Krka National Park. It's magnificent waterfalls, including the famous waterfall Skradinski Buk, are one of Croatia's most famous sights. After the sightseeing tour, we will return to Šibenik, a city of exceptional history and rich cultural heritage. Set out on a walking tour of Šibenik historical center and visit one of the most beautiful Renaissance Cathedrals of the Adriatic. Your night is at leisure in town.

Day 3 ŠIBENIK – GALEŠNJAK – ZADAR, Monday (B, L)

Leaving Šibenik early in the morning we set sail for Galešnjak, a typical small Dalmatian island, where you can enjoy a swim stop in one of secluded bays. Enjoy lunch while we cruise into Zadar harbour in the afternoon. Set out on a walking tour of Zadar historical center and admire the old walls and Port Gate built in 16th century. Visit the Square of the Five Wells, the Church of St. Donat, the Roman Forum and the largest Cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia. If there is a breeze, enjoy at the sea organ, an amazing art installation. Overnight in Zadar.

Day 4 ZADAR – SALI – NP KORNATI – PRIMOŠTEN, Tuesday (B, L)

Morning departure for Sali, a tourist town on Dugi Otok surrounded by hills, fields, bays and islets. Enjoy swimming in one of the secluded bays. We set sail for the National Park Kornati, comprised of 89 unforgettable islands, islets and reefs. The Kornati National Park is often mentioned as a "nautical paradise" and a rich marine eco-system. Afterwards we continue to Primošten built on a hill and dominated by the parish Church of St. George which was built in 1485. Your evening is at leisure in town.

Day 5 PRIMOŠTEN – VIS, Wednesday (B, L, CD)

We will have an early morning cruise towards the island of Vis, once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and closed to the public. Due to this isolation, Vis has a special charm – "the Mediterranean as it once was" making it really interesting to visit. Upon arrival in town of Vis join the walking tour to visit the remains of the Roman thermal place and views of the beautiful Villae Rusticae situated along the waterfront. Tonight, enjoy Captain's dinner onboard.

Day 6 VIS – BIŠEVO – HVAR – STARI GRAD, Thursday (B, L)

We will have an early morning cruise towards small island of Biševo to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. As sometimes weather conditions can be very unpredictable, the possibility of our visit will depend on those

conditions, however you will be notified of this on time. Enjoy a relaxing cruise as we sail towards the island of Hvar, with swim stop in one of the secluded bays. Hvar is a favourite holiday destination for international celebrities, but it's also a charming seaside town with 8 centuries of architecture. On a walking tour visit the old town with the picturesque little streets and the first public theatre in Europe. We will continue towards Stari Grad on the Hvar Island, the sunniest Adriatic island. The famous Stari Grad Field is the oldest in Croatia and the best preserved example of ancient Greek system of agriculture. It is a part of world heritage protected by UNESCO. Overnight in Stari Grad.

Day 7 STARI GRAD – BOL (Wine tasting) – SPLIT, Friday (B, L, T)

In the morning we will continue towards our final island destination - the island of Brač where swimming is planned at the most famous beach in Dalmatia – Golden Horn near Bol – whose pebbles shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change in shape. Join the visit to a Winery where you will have a guided winery tour to learn more about Dalmatian wines and enjoy a Wine tasting. We arrive in Split in the afternoon. This UNESCO World Heritage city bases the city centre in and around the stunning Diocletian's Palace, the Roman emperor Diocletian's retirement palace from 295–305 AD. Stroll through the palace basement filled with market stalls and outside experience the historical architecture of this beautiful palace. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's temple, the Peristyle and many other unique sites. Overnight in Split.

Day 8 SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Disembark after breakfast. You will be transferred to Split airport/hotel.

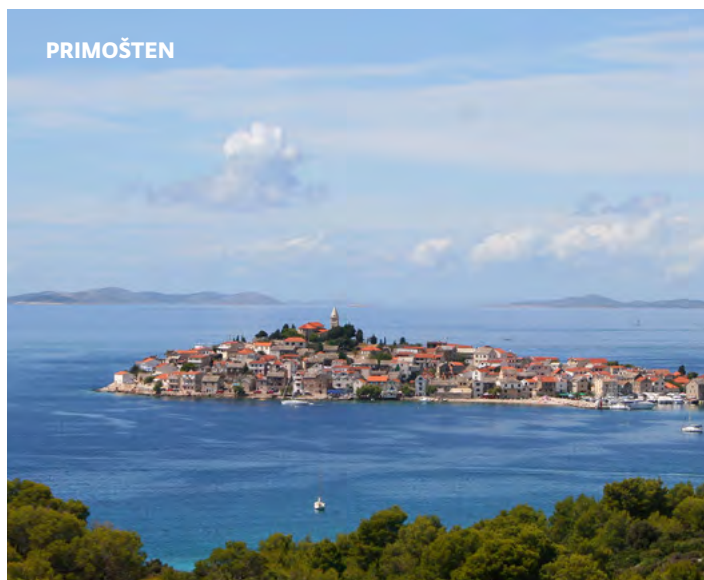

Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split's airport or your Split hotel to harbour, where embarkation begins at 13:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 SPLIT – TROGIR (NP Krka excursion), Sunday (B, L)

In the morning join a guided tour of Split, visit the seafront promenade and Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace. The historical center of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Set sail to the old Dalmatian town Trogir. Trogir is sometimes referred to as "miniature Venice" or a "mini Dubrovnik" because of its ancient walls, or a floating museum town - as it has a masterful architecture including some stunning Venetian palaces. After disembark in Trogir we will take the bus to visit Krka National Park. You will discover the pristine nature and waterfalls of the Krka National Park, an area extremely rich with flora and fauna. Overnight in Trogir.

Day 3 TROGIR – STARI GRAD, Monday (B, L)

Morning guided tour of Trogir with a local tour guide. Enjoy sailing towards Stari Grad on the island of Hvar, swimming stop and lunch on board. Stari Grad is one of the oldest towns in Europe with many friendly and cheap konobas and restaurants in the backstreets of the old town. The Stari Grad Plain and the old town centre of Stari Grad have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 2008. Your evening is free to explore Stari Grad on your own.

Day 4 STARI GRAD – HVAR – VIS, Tuesday (B, L)

Leaving Stari Grad in the morning towards city of Hvar. A sightseeing tour of Hvar town shows you the first public theatre in Europe and many more historical sites. Afterwards continue to Vis. The town of Vis is on the northern side of the island and was developed near the remains of ancient Issa, the first urban centre in Croatia, formed by the Greeks in 4th century B.C. Visit the remains of the Roman Baths, Church or Our Lady and City museum or take a walk enjoying the view of the beautiful Villae Rusticae situated along the coast. Your evening is free in Vis.

Day 5 VIS – BIŠEVO – KORČULA, Wednesday (B, L)

Leaving Vis we will have an early morning cruise towards Biševo island to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon on the islet Biševo just in front of the town of Komiza. As sometimes weather conditions can be very unpredictable, the possibility of our visit will depend on those conditions, however you will be notified of this on time. Afterwards cruise towards the Korčula the island's main settlement and is known as the birthplace of Marco Polo, one of the world's most famous explorers of all times. Stop for lunch in one of the secluded bays en route. Afternoon arrival in Korčula followed by a guided walking tour of one of the best preserved medieval cities in the Mediterranean. Korčula has an abundant choice of restaurants to enjoy your gourmet experience and there are numerous bars and clubs for those looking for evening entertainment. Overnight in Korčula.

Day 6 KORČULA – MLJET – SLANO (Oyster Tasting), Thursday (B, L, T, CD)

In the morning head further south to the Island of Mljet. Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters or kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. Lunch on board and departure for a small village called Slano on the mainland, a peaceful fishermen's village and the starting point to Ston, another once fortified small village famous for its oysters situated on Pelješac peninsula. No, our motorized sailing boats sail exclusively during daylight. During the night, they will moor in harbours or coves.

IS SLEEPING ON DECK PERMITTED?

It certainly is. For many of our guests, it is a unique experience to spend the night in the fresh air, under the Mediterranean stars.

IS THERE ENOUGH SHADE ABOARD?

Of course, there is enough shade aboard. Usually, bigger vessels have got a canopied part at the stern on the main deck, in addition to that, parts of the sundeck are protected by a canvas cover.

CAN I PAY WITH CREDIT CARD IN THE SHIP?

No, is not possible to pay with credit cards inside the boat, It's possible only to pay with local currency- Croatian Kuna

ARE CRUISE SHIPS WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE?

Due to the specific mooring conditions and requirements in some Croatian ports, ships are moored side by side, making it



necessary to cross from one ship to another with gaps in between, to get to the shore. In such cases guests need to take special care when crossing and do this at their own risk. Crew assistance will be given to those needing and requesting it but cruises are not recommended for clients in wheelchairs or with limited mobility.

ARE TOWELS PROVIDED ON BOARD?

For your comfort, bath towels are provided

on all our ships. There is the possibility of renting towels for the beach with a maximum cost of 7 euro per week.

WHAT ELECTRICITY IS ON BOARD?

In our Ships we have available electricity 220 V. Due to security measures it is not allowed to have plugs in the bathrooms of the cabins.

IS SMOKING ALLOWED ON BOARD?

Smoking in the restaurant area and in the cabins is not allowed. There will be a small-design-

nated area outside for smokers away from the general entertaining areas. Passengers must not throw cigarette butts in the sea.

ARE THERE BABY CRIBS AVAILABLE IN THE SHIPS?

Our Ships do not have baby cribs available, but in case any guest wants to bring their own baby crib, please inform us at the time of booking to try to assign a cabin with enough space for it.

GOOD TO KNOW

- In the event of adverse weather conditions, the captain can choose to alter the itinerary for the comfort and safety of the passengers.
- Tips are not included and are discretionary at the end of your cruise
- KOMPAS reserves the right to change the vessel provider in case the contracted services are not supplied according to previously agreed standards.
- All our cruises are equipped with lifejackets, rescue raft, fire alarm and complete navigation equipment (navigation radar, plotter, GPS, radio, etc).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

RESERVATION

For reservations, please contact your travel agent for assistance, send an e-mail to booking.adriatic.cruise@kompas-travel.com. All prices are based on tariffs in effect at the same time of publication of this manual, and are subject to reconfirmation at the time of booking. KOMPAS will check availability and send an email with the booking confirmation / proforma invoice.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT

In case of cruises a deposit of EUR 200 per person must be received at the time of booking. This deposit is non-refundable and forms part of your final payment. The balance is due 30 days prior to tour departure. If we do not receive final payment by the specified date, we reserve the right to cancel the reservation. Upon execution of the remaining balance or the full amount, Kompas will send travel document / voucher. Final invoice will be sent at the end of the tour. For late bookings (less than 30 days prior to departure), full payment is required at the time of booking. In the case of billing errors, we reserve the right to re-invoice with correct pricing. Service charge is not included in the price and therefore please tip at your own discretion.

CANCELLATION FEES

Cancellations must be advised to KOMPAS in writing. Per person cancellation fees apply as follows:

"Departure day" is considered the date Kompas services begin.

Flight and ferry tickets are 100% non refundable.

GUARANTEED DEPARTURES

In 2022 we intend to operate all our scheduled departures. In case of any unforeseen circumstances, Kompas reserves the absolute right to change and/or alter any specific departure date, and amend or cancel any of the arrangements for particular itinerary. Should insufficient numbers book the tour Kompas can close the departure. In the unlikely event that a departure is cancelled, we will re-book passengers on the same tour with a different departure date or a similar tour. All re-bookings are subject to availability. If that tour is unacceptable, Kompas will refund all funds paid to Kompas; there is no additional liability. Kompas cannot assume responsibility for any additional costs or fees relating to the issuance and/or cancellation of air tickets, ground transportation, extra accommodation surcharges, travel insurance, visa fees, taxes or any other travel arrangements not made through Kompas.

REFUNDS FOR UNUSED SERVICES

No refunds will be made for unused services (like transfer services) or unused part of the program included in tour price once travel arrangements have commenced, especially in the cases where passengers are unable to travel due to invalid travel documents (passports, visas). In case that client cannot find the arrival transfer/driver at the airports, they have to call emergency contact number in the travel documents.

COMPLAINTS

Any complaints regarding service have to be given directly to the KOMPAS representative (Tour Escort) on the spot. Any complaints regarding service on board have to be given directly on the ship to KOMPAS representative (Cruise Manager). Complaints have to be sent to KOMPAS within 15 days from the customer's departure. Otherwise, such complaints will not be taken into consideration.

TOUR MEMBERSHIP

In order to ensure congenial membership, Kompas reserves the right to accept or reject any person as a tour participant and to expel from the tour any participant whose conduct is deemed incompatible with the interests of the tour group.

INSURANCE

Kompas strongly recommends insurance to cover cancellation charges, trip interruption, accidents and baggage loss. Kompas accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of baggage or other personal property.

DELAYED ARRIVAL

We do not cover any refunds for missed /late flights and, subsequently, late arrival/no start of the tour. All additional costs have to be settled on the spot by passengers. We recommend that in case of delay clients call the emergency phone number which is in the travel documents.

PROGRAM PRICES

Program prices are per person, based on two persons sharing a room. Single room supplements and triple room reductions are listed where applicable. When applies, transfers are provided complimentary only from airports to hotel and vice versa by motor coach or private vehicle, only on the first and the last day of the tour, as per the itinerary, under the condition that accurate transfer information is provided. Pre-stay and post-stay transfers are not included in the tour rate, but can be arranged on request.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The hotels classified in KOMPAS brochure are based on local classifications, which vary from country to country. Hotels listed in this brochure will be used on almost all departures. If changes become necessary for any reason, booked accommodation can be substituted only by an accommodation unit of the same or higher category and at the price confirmed during booking. While every effort is made to reserve twin bedded rooms, it may happen that a hotel provides some double bedded rooms instead. If such thing happens, double bedded rooms will try to be allocated to couples. Triple share rooms are generally based on an extra rollaway bed, which is not always suitable for adults. Please note that standard policy is that hotel rooms are available for check-in after 14:00. Early check-in needs to be advised in advance and may require a pre-night to be booked and paid for. Because of the limited number of different cabins, we are not in a possibility to confirm or guarantee a specific type of bed, but we try to allocate guests according to their wishes. So if you demand a specific type of bed, we kindly ask you to note that to us while making a reservation, and we will try to fulfill your wishes.

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LOCAL HOLIDAYS

During national holidays certain facilities (museums, restaurants, sightseeing tours and shopping) may be limited or unavailable. Alternatives will be offered whenever possible.

LUGGAGE

In case of land tours, portage is not included in program price. No responsibility is accepted for loss or damage to baggage, travel documents or passenger's belongings, nor for luggage loss that occurred in the hotels or luggage left in the bus depots during night periods. Kompas will not accept responsibility for baggage damage caused by normal wear and tear in handling and transportation. All lost luggage on connecting flights are not responsibility of Kompas. We do not guarantee that the luggage will be found and delivered to assigned hotel. We will provide assistance on the spot (through our tour director and local offices) that will help the passenger communicate with airline company.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

A valid passport is required for all tour participants. All passengers, regardless of the passport they hold, should check with the appropriate consulates to determine if any visas are needed. Securing any needed visas is the responsibility of the tour participant.

TRAVELERS WHO NEED SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

Any disability requiring special attention must be reported to Kompas at the time of booking. Kompas will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the special needs of disabled tour participants, but is not responsible for any denial of services by carriers, hotels, lodges, restaurants, or other independent suppliers, nor any additional expenses incurred. Motor coaches and minibuses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. We regret we cannot provide individual assistance to a tour member for walking, dining, getting on/off motor coaches and other transportation vehicles, or other personal needs. Travelers who need assistance must be accompanied by a qualified and physically able companion. Motorized scooters are unsuitable for touring.

YOUNG TOUR PARTICIPANTS

Tour participants under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult. On escorted land tours we do not recommend children under the age of 8.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Tour participants should check with the consulates and local health boards for the latest health requirements. No medical expenses will be covered for illnesses that occur prior to arrival or on the tour.

PETS

Due to safety reasons and comfort for all passengers, animals are not allowed in our tours and cruises.

SAFETY

Please be aware that during your participation in tours operated by Kompas, certain risks and dangers may arise beyond our control including, but not limited to, the hazards of traveling in undeveloped areas; travel by boat, train, automobile, aircraft or other means of transportation; the forces of nature, political unrest and accident or illness in remote regions without means of rapid evacuation or medical facilities. Kompas will not have liability regarding provision of medical care or the adequacy of any care that may be rendered. It is understood that Kompas will use its best efforts to ensure that adequate measures are taken.

RESPONSIBILITY *** IMPORTANT

Kompas and/or its agents act only in the capacity of agent for the passengers in all matters pertaining to the tour, whether by plane, rail, motor coach, ferry, cruise boat or any other means of conveyance. They shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss caused by neglect or default of any company or person engaged in conveying the tour, or any hotel proprietor or other person supplying services or material in connection with the tour.

RESERVATION CHANGES-CRUISES

In case of Adriatic Cruise product (incl. Land & Cruise products), it is possible to change the reservation and do the name change until 30 days before departure without charging any fees. Extra costs will be applied in case of a different date/ cruise /cabin type. Within 30 days before departure standard cancellation fees will be applied.

FORCE MAJEURE

In case of any unforeseen circumstances during your cruise, including but not limited to: weather conditions, low or high waters, lock schedules, acts of God, government actions, political turmoil, disease, strikes, terrorism, general break down of equipment, closures or black outs of certain attractions listed in the program or similar, Kompas reserves the absolute right to change and/or alter any specific sailing date, itinerary or a series of departure dates including implementing any of the following: a) substituting vessels of same or similar quality, b) operating portions of the sailing program via motor coach/hotel accommodations to replace boat schedules, c) substituting listed attractions with those of same or similar quality without prior notice. The vessel operators also reserve the right to cancel any particular sailing date or series of departures, for reasons outlined above, lack of participation or for any other reasons beyond their control. In the unlikely event of a cancelled sailing date, in conjunction with the vessel owners/operators, we reserve the right to offer an alternate date. If that tour is unacceptable, Kompas will refund all funds paid to Kompas; there is no additional liability.

SHIPS

Passengers on board are obliged to abide to the ship rules, as captain is responsible for the safety of all passengers and the crew. Jumping and diving from the boat during navigation, as well as climbing on the masts, is strictly forbidden. Swimming far from the boat or the coast should be avoided. It is strictly forbidden to throw rubbish into the sea. It is not allowed to bring drinks and food on the boat, except personal care products, liquid medicine, food products for infants and special diets. Tap water on the ship is not safe for drinking. Water is scarce on every boat, therefore please be very rational with it. The same applies to the electricity which runs on the generator.
