Split round trip cruise

FROM SPLIT TO BOL, JELSA, KORČULA, DUBROVNIK, MLJET, HVAR AND RETURN TO SPLIT



Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split airport to the port. Embarkation starts at 14:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome Reception followed by dinner.

Day 2 SPLIT - BOL - JELSA, Sunday (B, L)

Morning sail towards Bol on Brač Island, where you will discover one of the most beautiful beaches in the entire Mediterranean - "Zlatni Rat" (the Golden Horn), which is constantly changing its shape due to the ocean currents. Swim stop if weather permits. Return to the ship for lunch and set sail for Jelsa on the island of Hvar. One of the most picturesque towns on the island of Hvar; Jelsa is nestled in amongst hills dense with pine woods. The town quay extends all the way around the harbour with numerous laid moorings. Walk around old stone street, squares, see churches, and parks. Enjoy a coffee in the main square and the Mediterranean atmosphere of this bustling town. Your evening is free to explore Jelsa on your own.

Day 3 JELSA – KORČULA (Wine tasting), Monday (B, L, T)

Early in the morning we set sail for the island

of Korčula, with swim stop, weather permiting, in one of pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. Continue towards Korčula, the most preserved medieval town, and birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Take a walking tour of Korčula which takes you through its narrow, cobbled streets full of history and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. Evening is free to explore the town on your own.

Day 4 KORČULA – DUBROVNIK, Tuesday (B, L)

In the morning sail to Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic", a famous UNESCO World Heritage site. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, you will enjoy a guided tour of the historical center of Dubrovnik, walk through Stradun – both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik. After city tour, you will be on your own to explore the city, visit City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's second oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace, and the Cathedral, or take a boat ride to Lokrum island or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Srd. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Day 5 DUBROVNIK – MLJET National Park, Wednesday (B, L, CD)

In the morning head further north to the Island of Mljet. Mljet National Park encompasses five types of forest, many species of birds and two deep lakes, Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and Malo Jezero (Small Lake). Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters, or kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. In the evening enjoy Captain's dinner on board.

Day 6 MLJET National Park – HVAR, Thursday (B, L)

Take a break for a swim during your morning cruise. Continue sailing during a lunch, afternoon arriving in Hvar, a charming seaside town with 8 centuries of architecture, and a favourite holiday destination for international celebrities. During a walking tour, visit the many historical sights of the town, such as St Stephen's Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above the town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over





the bay and Pakleni islands. Your evening is free in Hvar. You can explore more and dine on your own in one of the many restaurants in town.

Day 7 HVAR - SPLIT, Friday (B, L)

In the morning we head to our final port Split with a stop along the way to swim, cool off and relax, if weather permits, and lunch on board. In the late afternoon we arrive in Split. Take a walking tour of the historic inner city that takes us to the Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We see the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. Your evening is free in Split.

Day 8 SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

After breakfast it is time to disembark. You will be transferred to Split airport.

Split round trip cruise

FROM SPLIT TO NP KRKA, ŠIBENIK, ZADAR, PRIMOŠTEN, STARI GRAD, HVAR, VIS, BIŠEVO AND RETURN TO SPLIT



Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split airport to the port. Embarkation starts at 14:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 SPLIT – ŠIBENIK (Krka National Park excursion), Sunday (B, L)

Depart from Split early in the morning towards Šibenik with swim stop, weather permitting, in one of pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. After lunch disembark in Šibenik and continue by bus to visit Krka National Park. It's magnificent waterfalls, including the famous waterfall Skradinski Buk, are one of Croatia's most famous sights. After the sightseeing tour, we come back to Šibenik, a city of exceptional history and rich cultural heritage. Set out on a walking tour of Šibenik historical center and visit one of the most beautiful Renaissance Cathedrals of the Adriatic. Your evening is at leisure in town.

Day 3 ŠIBENIK – GALEŠNJAK – ZADAR (Wine tasting), Monday (B, L, T)

Early in the morning, we will leave Šibenik and set sail for Galešnjak, a typical small Dalmatian Island, where you will enjoy a swim stop in one of secluded bays. Enjoy lunch while we cruise into Zadar port. After arrival, join for a walking tour of

Zadar historical center and admire the old walls and Port Gate built in 16th century. Visit the Square of the Five Wells, see the Church of St. Donat, the Roman Forum and the largest Cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. If there is a breeze, enjoy at the "Sea Organ", an architectural sound art, which plays music by way of sea waives move into the tubes. Overnight in Zadar.

Day 4 ZADAR - PRIMOŠTEN, Tuesday (B, L)

Morning departure for Primošten, with a stop along the way for a swim and relax, if weather permits, with lunch on board. Primošten is a small, picturesque town situated between Šibenik and Trogir, in the central part of the Adriatic coast and surrounded by seven other islets, a wonderful sight and an exceptional breathtaking place to explore. Overnight in Primošten.

Day 5 PRIMOŠTEN - STARI GRAD, Wednesday (B, L)

In the morning we will continue towards the town of Stari Grad on the island of Hvar. We will sail pass by the most famous beach in Dalmatia – Golden Horn ("Zlatni rat") near Bol – whose pebbles shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change in shape. Swim stop near Golden Horn ("Zlatni rat") is possible (weather permitted). We head off to Hvar Island where we'll visit Stari Grad.

Stari Grad is one of the oldest towns in Europe with many friendly konobas and restaurants in the backstreets of the old town. The Stari Grad Plain and the old town center of Stari Grad have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 2008. Your evening is free to explore Stari Grad on own.

Day 6 STARI GRAD – HVAR – VIS, Thursday (B, L, CD)

Our morning cruise starts with Hvar Town. Hvar is a charming seaside town and a favourite holiday destination for international celebrities. During a walking tour through the old town and its picturesque little streets, you will see many historical sites, such as St Stephen's Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above the town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and Pakleni islands. After lunch disembark in Vis and continue by bus to visit Komiža a charming and lively fishing village located on the southwest side of the island of Vis, where you can walk and enjoy the unique Mediterranean atmosphere and history that is reflected in every stone house, narrow streets, fishing boats that dominate the harbour. After that, we return to the town of Vis, one of the most remote Croatian islands, which remained inaccessible to visitors due to the presence of a







military base until 1989. When the island finally opened to tourism, Vis retained the impression of wild, untouched beauty that captivated those looking to get off the beaten track. In the evening enjoy Captain's dinner on board.

Day 7 VIS - BIŠEVO - SPLIT, Friday (B, L)

We will have an early morning cruise towards small island of Biševo to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. Visiting the cave is permitted depending on weather conditions. We arrive in Split in the afternoon. This UNESCO World Heritage city bases the city center around the stunning Diocletian's Palace, the Roman emperor Diocletian's retirement palace from 295–305 AD. Stroll through the palace basement filled with market stalls and experience the historical architecture of this beautiful palace. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, as well as its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's temple, the Peristyle, and many other unique sites. Overnight in Split.

Day 8 SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Disembark after breakfast. You will be transferred to Split airport.

Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split airport, where embarkation begins at 15:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 SPLIT - ŠIBENIK Sunday (B, L)

In the morning join a guided tour of Split, visit the seafront promenade and Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace. The historical center of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Set sail to Šibenik and set out on a walking tour of Šibenik historical center and visit one of the most beautiful Renaissance Cathedrals of the Adriatic. Your night is at leisure in town.

Day 3 ŠIBENIK – NP KRKA – VODICE – ZADAR, Monday (B, L)

We start the day with breakfast, followed by a bus visit to the Krka National Park. It's magnificent waterfalls, including the famous waterfall Skradinski Buk, are one of Croatia's most famous sights. After the sightseeing tour, we continue sailing towards Zadar, swimming stop and lunch on board. Set out on a walking tour of Zadar historical center and admire the old walls and Port Gate built in 16th century. Visit the Square of the Five Wells, the Church of St. Donat, the Roman

Forum and the largest Cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia. If there is a breeze, enjoy at the sea organ, an amazing art installation. Overnight in Tadar

Day 4 ZADAR - RAB, Tuesday (B, L, T)

Departure towards Rab, known as the "Island of Love", with an old town of the same name, with swimming stop. Guided city tour including the medieval walls and the famous four bell towers (you can climb one of them) along with palaces, churches, and squares where many artists paint and exhibit their works. Legend has it that the local nuns created a special Rab cake for the pope who visited Rab. We stop for a tasting of traditional Rab cake. You can see how is made, learn about it, taste it, you can even go to a workshop and try to make it by yourself. The recipe for the Rab cake remains a secret kept only by the islanders. Overnight in the town of Rab.

Day 5 RAB - MALI LOŠINJ, Wednesday (B, L)

Early this morning we set sail for the beautiful and untouched island of Lošinj, known as the "Island of Wellness and Vitality" and the "Island of the Sun". It is also known for its lush green vegetation, pine trees, wildflowers, and herbs. After stopping for a swim in the crystal-clear Adriatic, we arrive in the town of Mali Lošinj, which boasts one of

the most beautiful harbors on the Adriatic. Upon arrival, take a walk along the beautiful waterfront where there are nice shops, restaurants, and attractive cafes. The main tourist attraction is the Museum of Apoxyomenos. It is dedicated to the ancient bronze statue of Apoxyomenos, which was found in 1999 on the seabed near the islet of Vela Orjula at a depth of 45 meters. If you are interested in art, be sure to visit on your own the Fritzi Palace - Lošinj Museum, which houses a rich collection of works by Croatian and European artists. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

Day 6 MALI LOŠINJ – SALI, Thursday (B, L, CD)

Departure after breakfast and a stop to swim in one of the quiet bays. Enjoy the incredibly clean sea. After lunch, sailing along the Kornati National Park to the small fishing village of Sali, a tourist town on Dugi Otok (Long Island) with a thousand-year-old history of fishing and the nearest town to the "Telašćica" Nature Park. It is mentioned in the 12th century, having received its name from its salt works, and today it is a favourite destination for divers. Sali is a place of a thousand-year-old fishing tradition, which was confirmed by written documents from the 10th century. Tonight, aboard our ship, enjoy the Captain's dinner.







Day 7 SALI - HVAR, Friday (B, L)

Take a swim break during the morning cruise. Continue sailing during the lunch, arriving in the afternoon in Hvar, a favourite vacation destination of world celebrities, but also a charming seaside town with 8-century-old architecture. You can walk through the old town with picturesque alleys and see the first public theatre in Europe (older than Shakespeare's theatre in Great Britain), the Franciscan monastery and much more and dine on your own at one of the many restaurants in town. The evening in Hvar is free.

Day 8 HVAR - SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Early morning departure for Split. After breakfast it is time to disembark. You will be transferred to Split airport.



Dubrovnik to Split one way cruise

FROM DUBROVNIK TO ELAPHITI ISLANDS, SLANO, MLJET, KORČULA, BIŠEVO, VIS, HVAR, STARI GRAD AND SPLIT

In the morning we head north to the Island of Mljet. Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Continue our cruise towards the Korčula island, best known as

a birthplace of Marco Polo. Early morning departure to the old Dalmatian town Trogir. Trogir is sometimes referred to as "miniature Venice" or a "mini-Dubrovnik" because of its ancient walls, or a "floating museum town" - as it has a masterful architecture including some than a venetian palaces. Afterwards, you will discover the beauty of the Krka National Park and the small access port of Skradin where the flora and fauna are exceptional. Overnight in Trogir.

Day 7 TROGIR - SPLIT, Friday (B, L)





Water dispenser available throughout the cruise. A bar is available on all ships serving a selection of beers, wine, spirits and soft drinks. All drinks purchased on board are payable in cash at the end of your cruise. We do not allow any drinks or food bought on-shore to be brought on board the ships. We suggest you not to drink tap water.

Is there a doctor aboard?

There is no doctor aboard, but the crew is qualified for giving first aid. However, in every port there are specialized medical teams or health facilities.

Is a cruise suitable for children?

Of course it is. And without any doubt, it is a great experience for children. Because of the special conditions aboard, we recommend our cruises for children at least at school age, and they should be able to swim.

How much luggage can I take aboard?

Generally, there is no limit, but you should keep in mind that the space in the cabins is restricted. If you hate packing, no worries, you only need to bring a bathing suit and couple of shorts and T-shirts on our cruise - don't overpack.

Do motorized sailing boats sail during the night?

No, our motorized sailing boats sail exclusively during daylight. During the night, they will moor in harbours or coves.

Is sleeping on deck permitted?

It certainly is. For many of our guests, it is a unique experience to spend the night in the fresh air, under the Mediterranean stars.

Is there enough shade aboard?

Of course, there is enough shade aboard. Usually, bigger vessels have got a canopied part at the stern on the main deck, in addition to that, parts of the sundeck are protected by a canvas cover.

Can I pay with credit card on the ship?

Payment on the ship can be settled in cash at the end of the cruise. Local currency for all payments is EURO.

Are cruise ships wheelchair accessible?

Due to the specific mooring conditions and requirements in some Croatian ports, ships are moored side by side, making it necessary to cross from one ship to another with gaps in between, to get to the shore. In such cases guests need to





take special care when crossing and do this at their own risk. Crew assistance will be given to those needing and requesting it but cruises are not recommended for clients in wheelchairs or with limited mobility.

Are towels provided on board?

For your comfort, bath towels and a beach towel are provided on all our ships. There is the possibility of renting towels for the beach with a maximum cost of 7 euro per pcs/week.

What electricity is on board?

In our Ships we have available electricity 220 V. Due to security measures it is not allowed to have plugs in the bathrooms of the cabins.

Is smoking allowed on board?

Smoking in the restaurant area and in the cabins is not allowed. There will be a small-designated area outside for smokers away from the general entertaining areas. Passengers must not throw cigarette butts in the sea.

Are there baby cribs available in the ships?

Our Ships do not have baby cribs available, but in case any guest wants to bring their own baby crib, please inform us at the time of booking to try to assign a cabin with enough space for it.

What if I have dietary requirements?

The cuisine on board is a combination of Mediterranean and international cuisine, with traditional Croatian dishes, and includes seafood typical of the region. If you have any dietary requirements, we kindly ask you to provide information in advance to enable the chef to accommodate these dietary needs upon arrival.

Is there a laundry service on board?

No.
